

## Performance Information 2009

All students should have received an informational sheet from their instructor. This sheet outlines rehearsal/performance dates, arrival times, and required attire. Please let the front desk know if you have not received one.

### **Pictures**

This year, Season Finale pictures will be taken during dress rehearsals at the Highline Performing Arts Center.

"5,6,7,8..." and "Irish, Live!" students will take pictures at the "5,6,7,8..." dress rehearsal on Monday, June 22nd.

Ballet students performing in "The Sleeping Beauty" will have their pictures on their respective dress rehearsal date: June 29th for July 1st cast and June 30th for the July 2nd cast.

Dance students will be provided with a schedule indicating the specific time for their class picture. Please make every effort to ensure your dancer is present and in costume fifteen minutes prior to their scheduled picture time! ### **Dress Rehearsal**

- Please arrive on time, with hair and make-up done.
- Please arrive in clothing appropriate for warm-ups. Do not wear your costume to the theatre. Dancers will change into their costume prior to having their picture taken.
- Please enter the theatre from the stage door marked "Momentum Student Entrance" on the Southeast corner of Highline Performing Arts Center and the East side of the Renton IKEA Center. Students and volunteers sign in at the stage door and parents will be excused from backstage. Front lobby doors will be locked.
- Only volunteers and dancers are allowed in the dressing rooms. Boys may dress in the men's restroom located in the green room.
- Parents are invited to watch dress rehearsal from the auditorium or return to pick them up after rehearsal. Dancers may watch the opposite Act during dress rehearsal (parent volunteers will be assisting with this). If dancers choose to go into the auditorium, they should either change out of their costume or have it covered.
- Photography and videotaping are allowed on dress rehearsal nights ONLY. **No flash photography please.** (If you are using a tripod, please set up in the back 5 rows.)
- Please send a non-messy snack and water bottle with your child for dress rehearsals and performances. Please keep all snacks in the dressing rooms. **(No peanut, nut, or banana products please.)**
- Students will be excused/signed out from the auditorium area after dress rehearsals and from the main lobby area after performances. (We will go over this procedure at dress rehearsal.)

### **Performance**

- Please arrive on time, with hair and make-up done.
- Please arrive in clothing appropriate for warm-ups. Do not wear your costume to the theatre. Dancers will change into their costume prior to their performance (parent volunteers will be assisting with this).
- Please enter the theatre from the stage door marked "Momentum Student Entrance" on the Southeast corner of Highline Performing Arts Center and the East side of the Renton IKEA Center. Students and volunteers sign in at the stage door and parents will be excused from backstage.
- Only volunteers and dancers are allowed in the dressing rooms. Boys may dress in the men's restroom located in the green room.
- Please send a non-messy snack and water bottle with your child for dress rehearsals and performances. Please keep all snacks in the dressing rooms. **(No peanut, nut, or banana products please.)**
- Parents keep all valuables with you.
- After the performance has started, **late seating will be during Intermission only.**
- If you have small children needing some extra "wiggle" room, please remain seated in the back of the auditorium.
- **No photography or videotaping permitted during the performance.**
- DVDs of the performance will be made available. Order forms are currently at the front desk and will also be at all of the performances. Costs will vary by performance. DVDs are courtesy of [Final Take Productions](#).
- Students will be excused/signed out from the main lobby area after all performances. Please do not go back stage or to the dressing rooms to pick up your child. Volunteers will bring your child to you. You will be allowed backstage to pick up your child's belongings as soon as students are properly dismissed. Thank you for your cooperation.
